WHAT IS A CHRISTIAN?

A Christian is not perfect (sinless). My little children, these things write I unto you, that ye sin not. And if any man sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous: And he is the propitiation for our sins: and not for ours only, but also for [the sins of] the whole world. (1 John 2:1, 2) A Christian can and does sin, but when he does, there is help from his advocate, Jesus Christ.

A Christian is a follower (disciple) of Christ. ...And the disciples were called Christians first in Antioch. (Acts 11:26) Be ye followers of me, even as I also [am] of Christ. (1 Corinthians 11:1) A true disciple desires to be like his master, even if that means following the steps of Jesus into death.

A Christian is one who believes (has faith) in Jesus as the Lord and Saviour, and as a result wants to tell everyone about him.

A Christian is one who has turned their life around from serving self and sin (repentance), toward serving the Lord. I tell you, Nay: but, except ye repent, ye shall all likewise perish. (Luke 13:3) Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost. (Acts 2:38)

A Christian is one who has been buried with Christ in the waters of baptism, and been resurrected to a new life in Christ. (Romans 6:3-5)

A Christian is one who is member of the body of Christ, which is His Church. Praising God, and having favour with all the people. And the Lord added to the church daily such as should be saved. (Acts 2:47) See also: (1 Corinthians 12:12-13; Ephesians 1:22-23)

A Christian is one who has their affections (mind) set on heaven, which is their goal. (Col. 3:1-4; Phil. 3:20)

The only definition of the word Christian is one found in the Bible. Let us eliminate all the man-made names and simply go by the name in the Bible—Christian.
